Detail Report:

National Service Scheme (NSS) camp was organized by Abhinav Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Narhe, Pune during the period of 26th Feb to 4th March 2023 at Hartali Village, in Wadwadi, BhorTaluka, District-Pune. NSS was established in 1969 with a vision of personality development of students through community service as well as development of rural areas in India. NSS Unit has been introduced in colleges with an optimism of establishing a sense of social responsibility amongst students and inculcating values of self-discipline and selfless dedication towards community development. As a part of NSS Activities, a 7 day camp was held by AES's College of Pharmacy at Hartali Village. Various social activities were held with a sole view of rural development and value education. We undertook various activities in the village to promote interaction with the villagers and used the NSS platform to spread awareness about different social issues.





Day 1: Sunday, 26/02/2023 THE ORIENTATION PROGRAM







The coordinators of NSS camp gathered all the volunteers for an orientation session in the college campus at 10:00 a.m. During this session the coordinators explained about importance of NSS camp, role of volunteers, schedule of the camp and the tasks that volunteers have to carry out. The volunteers were informed about rules and duties to be followed in the camp. Senior volunteers from BCA campus of Abhinav Education Society shared their experience with current volunteers. Volunteers were divided in groups for different task forces in the camp. The faculty coordinators collected the consent forms from students duly signed by their parents. Finally the session ended with excitement and enthusiasm of the volunteers to be a part of NSS special camp. At 1:00 p.m. the volunteers along with faculty coordinators left the college premises by college bus and reached the Wadwadi campus at 3:30 p.m. After refreshment volunteers prepared for inauguration ceremony.





Day 2: Monday, 27/02/2023 THE INAUGURATION CEREMONY AND SWACCHA BHARAT ABHIYAN









For inauguration program of Special camp at Hartali village, renowned people from village were invited. Inauguration program started with lighting of the lamps and welcoming of the guests. It was followed by introduction of the chief guests and their felicitation. The vision, mission and the main purpose of the NSS camp was put forth by Mrs. Sonali Wagh, Program Officer for NSS Unit of AES's COP. The programproceeded with different speeches given by the guests present for the ceremony. The opening ceremony was concluded by recital of VandeMataram. Students proceeded for "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" in Hartali village after the inauguration ceremony, where they cleaned the grounds and also created awareness regarding cleanliness among common people. The Inauguration was then followed by a session for volunteers by Dr. NandkishorSarode on topic "Thoughts of Gandhiji and Societal change".





Day 3: Tuesday, 28/02/2023 TREE PLANTATION









Third day of camp started with warm-up exercise being done by volunteers as well as staff at 6 am, it was followed daily throughout the special camp. On this day tree plantation was organized, so volunteers and staff members planted various saplings in the surrounding area of AES's College of Engineering, Wadwadi Campus and raised awareness regarding global warming and importance of trees among the hostel students. The program then followed with the session of Dr. RajendraPatankar on the topic "Healthcare".





Day 4: Wednesday, 01/03/2023 YOGA SESSION









The fourth day of camp started early in the morning. The volunteers gathered in the campus and the report of the work carried out during the previous day was discussed. With the intention of creating awareness among all the students, a yoga session was organized on this day for which Dr. BhagyashreeVaidya(Diploma in Naturopathy and Yogik Science) was invited to the adopted village. During the session, various Asanas were performed by the volunteers and staff. At the end of this session the Yoga Instructor guided the students about the simple exercises which they can do every day. The session concluded with Shawasan. Later on a talk was delivered by Mr. Vijay Khutwad creating awareness about ShivajiMaharaj and his history.





Day 5: Thursday, 02/03/2023 HEALTH CHECK-UP









The fifth day of camp started with warm-up exercise being done by volunteers. After breakfast at 8:00 am the volunteers along with staff proceeded for Health check-up which was organized for local people. As a part of this health check-up, volunteers monitored the blood pressure and blood glucose levels (Diabetes) of local people and suggested a consultation with physician in case of some abnormalities. As a part of patient counselling volunteers gave home visit to villagers and explained them harmful effects of tobacco and other habit forming substances as well as common diseases along with measures to avoid it. After the evening snacks volunteers proceeded for a session by Chairman Dr. Savita Shinde on the topic "Woman Awareness" and Mrs. VaishaliChavan on topic "Woman Empowerment"





Day 6: Friday, 03/03/2023 TREKKING









On the sixth day, after the morning routine, the volunteers went trekking with the faculty members in Sangamner, for the purpose of developing the spirit of adventure and thrill among the students. The students enjoyed the trekking a lot and learned about team spirit. It was indeed a memorable day to all the volunteers. Later on they return to the campus and had snacks. The evening session comprised of a lecture by Dr. Sanjay Kandekar (Principal of AES's College of Computer Science) on the topic "Competitive exams" and Mr. Vishal Shelar on the topic "Reasons to obey Law of Constitution."





Day 7: Saturday 04/03/2023 CLEANLINESS DRIVE









The last day of NSS special camp started with routine activities of the morning session. After the Morning Prayer, thought of the day, NSS song (Lakshyageet) and the national anthem; volunteers gathered in the college campus for cleanliness drive. They collected garbage dumped around the college hostel and cleaned the area. A talk was delivered by Mr. Prashant Patil on "Business Opportunities" for volunteers. After the session, each of the volunteers shared their experience about the special camp, the faculty members also gave their feedback. Finally the camp came to an end by singing the National Anthem. At the end of the special camp, the volunteers compiled a note on all the events that took place during the special camp. We return to college around 6:00 p.m.

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
