Medication errors such as overdose and misuse as well as drug exposure during pregnancy and breastfeeding are often of concern, even without an adverse event, as they can result in an ADR. PVs role is to assess which adverse effects involves are. Case-control, Prospective study, spontaneous report in the case is the population of the single case report.
